All departments have submitted, for all current CBCS students transitioning to the four-year UG, their respective course structures and syllabi to the Registrar's Office. These will be included in the University Prospectus and the Syllabus Handbook for the upcoming academic year.

The evaluation shall include two types of assessments

The Continuous Assessment would be 30% in weightage and Summative Assessment will be 70% in weightage with the Pass Criteria being same as in campus programmes.

The evaluation will be carried out through varied assessment tools available on the Online Learning and Examination Platform, including multiple choice questions, projects, reports, case studies, presentations and end-term examinations.
